# Youth Summer Service

Teens set out to "serve" within our diocese and the diocese of Patterson. Each day they went to a different site to experience the needs there and volunteer.

Theme: of the week was "The Road" Each night during program we would talk a little more about Jesus walk to Emmaus and relate it to "the road" we are on. Each team met in small groups to discuss. After some free time teens then meet up with their own youth group for small group sharing time and prayer.

Every morning started off with daily mass at 7:30 AM. We were blessed to have Fr. Juan Gabriel with us on Tuesday and Msgr. Tom on Wednesday. Wednesday evening we had Adoration and reconciliation with Bishop Michael Saporito.

Here is what our youth volunteers did: St. Michael Convent, Newark: they cleaned up and painted many of the rooms for the nuns that live there. St Ann's Soup Kitchen-Newark, they sorted, packed and prepared meals for those in need. Gate of Heave Cemetery, East Hanover: they did a lot of garbage removal and built and painted bird sanctuaries in which they were able to memorialize with the name of one of there loved ones. Sacred Heart School: Bloomfield: school is only being used for parish functions and religious education. School is in very poor condition and in need of a lot of TLC. Youth worked with the DRE to clean the classrooms, re-organize things and mopped many of the floors in the building. There is no custodian and building has not been cleaned in over 2 years. Fr. English Center Food pantry: Patterson: Youth helped to sort food and clothing, bagged things up for those in need and distributed it to people who came.

The youth are having a blast and already talking about coming back next year!
