- 1. What does the Gospel from Sunday tell you about call and response?
- 2. Different types of fishermen need different skills: sailing, casting, maintaining nets, reading charts, etc. If Jesus asked you to be "fisher of men," what skills could you bring?
- 3. There are four parts to Jesus' proclamation in verse 15. Carefully think through and explain each part.
  - a. The time is fulfilled
  - b. The kingdom of God is at hand
  - c. Repent
  - d. Believe in the Gospel
- 4. Take a moment and reflect on your everyday life.
  - a. Where is the kingdom of God throughout your average day?
  - b. How can you work to be more consistently aware of God's kingdom all around you and within you?
