

Nicole - Information for both Year 1 Beginnings and Year 2 Blessed children- slides 10-15

- •Classes are held in room 102/103 for grades 1-4. Please read the scheduled dates and mark on the calendar only one program in room 102/103 at a time.
- •All sessions are fun, interactive, large group sessions, with small group time for table activities and discussions. I am present at the sessions to support teachers throughout the session.
- •Please attend Mass with your children & pray with them at home, practice the Hail Mary and Lord's Prayer
- •Children's Liturgy of the Word begins Sept. 24 at 10:00am Mass
- •Please keep us abreast of anything going on with your child that you feel would be important for us to know, our door is always open, all is confidential

Routine

Routine is very important for young children. We keep the routine the same at all sessions. We will begin each session with the following as a group:

- The Gathering Song beginning of each session
- Opening Prayer (Sign of the Cross) the Lord's Prayer
- The Sacred Space lesson
- A video with the class theme
- Closing prayer the Hail Mary

Arrival and check in Procedure Arrival is through the main Meaney Hall door

- Please arrive on time, by 3:45 (A&C), by 5:30 (B&D)
- When you walk into the main door of Meaney Hall you will see the check in table.
- You and your child will be greeted by a volunteer at the check in table.
- We will take attendance at the table, give your child a nametag and we send the child into room 102/103.

Door schedule/late arrivals

- Main entrance door of Meaney Hall unlocked for arrivals 3:30- 3:55 (Group A & C) 5:15-5:40 (Group B & D)
- The door will be locked at 4:00pm and 5:45pm for the safety of the children.
- If you arrive after that time, please knock on the door and we will let you in and escort your child into the class.


Pick up procedure Pick up is through the main Meaney Hall door

- The door will open by 4:30 (A&C) and 6:15 (B&D) for pick up.
- When you walk into the main door of Meaney Hall please line up at the table.
- You will be greeted by a volunteer at the table, we will ask you to give us your child's name.
- We will call your child to exit the door in 103 closest to the entrance/pick up hallway.

Health updates & attendance

- We follow the health and safety procedures of the Archdiocese of Newark and the State of NJ
- Medical paperwork If your child has a medical need please let us know in the next week as certain paperwork is needed. For example, if an epi pen is needed please see us for paperwork to be filled out.
- If your child is not feeling well, please keep them home to rest and get better. We ask that you
 notify Marielle Brown as early as possible via email if your child will be absent

- We take attendance at every session, if absent the lesson will be emailed to the parents by the end
 of the week for you to review with your child.
- **NO FOOD IN SESSIONS** Please keep food and drink at home unless medically necessary as we have many children with food allergies.
 - Do not send in a water bottle with your child unless they really use it and need it. We threw out about 50 water bottles that were left behind last year and not recovered in the lost and found. We are only in for a short while so if needed have your child eat a snack before they arrive.



Year 1 Beginnings Program

- The First Year of your child's Faith Formation please visit Saint Helen if your child has not been here before, so they are comfortable.
- There is one in person each month please try to attend all sessions
- There is one at home lesson once a month emailed to you by Nicole on the dates listed on the schedule. There is no homework to be sent back. You the parent will do the lesson with your child at home together.
- Learning prayers The Lord's Prayer, the Hail Mary, Glory be and more
- Prayer booklets made each month in class and sent home in March.
- Based on Our Sunday Visitor publication Outline of the year will be sent home after the first class.

Year 2 Blessed Program

- The second year of your child's two-year Sacrament preparation program for First Reconciliation and First Communion.
- Dynamic Catholic is our curriculum and teaches the children how much God loves them, how they are truly blessed and how to be the best version of themselves
- Sessions meet in person twice a month
- Attendance is required for all classes, no switching of sessions
- First Reconciliation workbook Sept. 2023 Jan. 2024 (First Reconciliations)
- First Communion workbook Feb. 2024 March 2024 First Communions May 2024

First Reconciliation - dates & practices

First Reconciliation Dates – we do not take requests, please make note of the registration date and time for you to get the session you need. 165 children about 55 children per session per 5 Priests.

- Jan. 19, 2024 At 5:30pm
- Jan 20, 2024 At 11:30am
- Jan. 20, 2024 at 2:00pm
- First Reconciliation Practices- Required attendance during class times already on the schedule January 16 & January 18, 2024. Parents do not attend.

First Reconciliation - registration

First Reconciliation preparation and Registration:

- We will prepare the children for this Sacrament from September until January in class.
- You register your child for one First Reconciliation date through a registration link just as you did for the parent meeting but using your CHILD'S NAME.
- We email you the First Reconciliation registration link to the email on your mysainthelen account.
- Registration opens Wednesday, November 1 at 9:00am
- You will be emailed a receipt stating the time and date that you registered your child for. Please make sure you hit the buttons "submit" and "complete registration".
- You will get a receipt and that is how you know you have registered.
- Baptismal Certificates must be scanned and sent to Marielle Brown at <u>mbrown@sainthelen.org</u> or a copy brought to Parish Center by Nov. 1, 2023. If your child was Baptized at Saint Helen we already have the information so no need to send us anything

First Communion - registration

 - We email you the First Communion registration link to the email on your mysainthelen account and it opens Thursday, Feb. 1, 2024 at 9:00am.
 - You will be emailed a receipt stating the time and date that you registered for. Please make sure you hit the buttons "submit" and "complete registration"
- You will get a receipt and that is how you know you have registered.
- We do not take requests, please make note of the registration date and time for you to get the session you need.

First Communion information

- Children will sit together in first 4 pews in center two pew banks
- Each child receives one at a time from Msgr. Tom
- Children need to be dropped off in the Chapel by 11:00am or 1:30pm for Procession line up.
- Procession of the children before each Mass 11:15 or 1:45.
- Open seating for all families no reserved seating
- Special needs must be told to us by April 25.
- Church opening time TBD
- Live streamed- link sent week of the Communions.


